1. Introduction

- 1.1. At Community Draws, we respect your privacy and are committed to protecting your personal data. 2. Controller

- 5.2.3. **Device** Data includes device type, operating system, and browser version.
- 5.2.4. Financial Data includes payment card details.
- 5.2.5. **Social Media** Data includes information obtained when you engage with our website through social media platforms or allow access to your social media profiles.
- 5.2.6. **Transaction** Data includes payment details and product or service purchase information.
- 5.2.7. **Technical** Data includes IP address, login data, browser type, time zone, location, and device technology.
- 5.2.8. **Profile** Data includes your username, password, purchases, orders, interests, preferences, feedback, and survey responses.
- 5.2.9. **Usage** Data includes information about how you use our website, products, and services.
- 5.2.10. Marketing and Communications Data includes your marketing preferences and communication choices.
- 5.2.11. We also collect, use, and share Aggregated Data, which is not considered personal data. If Aggregated Data becomes identifiable when combined with personal data, we treat it as personal data.
- 5.2.12. We do not collect Special Categories of Personal Data or information about criminal convictions and offenses.
- 5.2.13. We may collect the minimum personal data required for your entry into Prize Draws, Competitions, or Promotions.

6. Failure to Provide Personal Data

6.1. If providing certain personal data is required by law or necessary for fulfilling a contract, and you fail to provide it when requested, we may not be able to deliver the services or meet the obligations of the contract. Consent

Freely given, specific, informed, and unambiguous indication of the data subject's agreement to the processing of their personal data.

Cookies

Small pieces of data stored on your device when visiting websites, used to remember information about your browsing habits.

Legitimate Interest

Anonymized Data

Aggregated Data

Data that has been compiled from multiple sources but is not personally identifiable on its own.
